



Rangemaster Tactical Conference  
2018 Pistol Match Scores and Standings  
March 16-18, 2018  
Little Rock, AR

The 2018 pistol match was a challenging event, with three separate phases for the men and two phases for the ladies.

The first phase of the match was a timed course on turning target stands, using silhouette targets. Maximum possible score was 200.

The top female shooters' scores were:

In all, 26 women shot the match, with an average score of 165.12. The Top scorers, listed above, then went into a one-on-one shoot-off with reactive mannequin targets. At the completion of the shoot-off, the top three ladies were:

Among the men, 155 shooters completed the preliminary match with an average score of 188.86 out of a possible 200. A total of 38 men shot a perfect 200 score, so they went on to the second phase of the match.

In the second phase, these 38 men shot a quick course — Justin Dyal's excellent "Five Yard Round-Up" — again on turning targets, to increase the

pressure. Only one shooter, Mas Ayoob, shot a perfect 100% score on this one. The top 16 scores from this phase went on to a man-vs-man shoot-off, again on reactive mannequin targets. The Top 16 were:
